

THE COE MAKES A STORY OF SUCCESS FOR COOPERATION IN JORDAN



1. BENEFITS OF THE CONSOTRIUM A. LIBRARIES CAN HAVE A WORLD SYSTEM THAT A SINGLE ONE CANNOT HAVE BECAUSE OF ITS HIGH COST.

B. THE SYSTEM HAS ONE ADMINSTATION OFFICE, THUS REDUCING THE RUNNING COST.

C. A LIBRARY ITEM (A BOOK) IS CAGALOGED ONLY ONCE.

D. HAVING ONE UNION CATALOG FOR ALL MEMBER LIBRARIES.

E. EFFECTIVE INTERLIBRARY LOAN AMONG MEMEBERS.

F. (JOINT SUBSCRIPTIONS) THE POSSIBILITY OF OWNING A LARGER NUMBER OF WORLD DATABASES THAT SMALL INSTITUTIONS CANNOT HAVE INDVIDUALLY.

G. THE CONSORTIUM PROVIDES A NEGUCIATION POWER WITH PUBLISHERS THAT INDVIDUAL INSTITUTIONS CANNOT ENJOY ALONE.

F. MEMBER UNIVERSITIES CAN SHARE THE REPOSITORIES OF OTHER MEMEBERS.

- 1. Widening the consortia subscriptions to increase the amount of vital information to its educational and research community.
- 2. Extending the idea of consortia databases subcriptioions to book acquisition.

4. Trying to increase a fixed financial support from the Scientific Research Funds to the COE.

CONCLUSION:

- 1. The Jordanian experience provides an empirical evidence of the importance of the cooperative efforts to build an effective library consortia.
- 2. The experience provides an evidence for securing advanced services to the research community at universities.

- 3. The experience indicates the substantial size of savings.
- 4. The experience shows the feasibility of consortia subscriptions.
- 5. The experience shows that it is time to move from theory to practice.
- 6. The consortium has domesticated world library knowledge and technology in Jordan.

7. The consortium has led to the development and improvement in the teaching of Library and Information Science at Jordanian universities to cope with the new knowledge and technology brought into the libraries of public universities.
